- 1. **The shows are sanctioned by ADGA** and their show rules shall govern. The shows are separately sanctioned for Senior Does and Junior Does.
- 2. **The shows will begin** at 1:00 PM on Saturday and 8:00am on Sunday. Three rings will begin simultaneously each day. The judges will move rings after each breed is complete, with the animals staying in place. Below is the tentative show order:

JR Does:

Ring 1: Lamancha, AOP

Ring 2: Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine Ring 3: Nubian, Recorded Grade

SR Does:

Ring 1: Lamancha, Toggenburg, AOP

Ring 2: Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, Oberhasli

Ring 3: Nubian, Recorded Grade

- 3. To keep the show progressing in a timely manner, **the order of the show is subject to change**. Exhibitors with more than one breed need to be prepared to have additional handlers ringside.
- 4. **Base date** for figuring age of animals is August 7th^h, 2021
- 5. The original registration/recordation certificate is required for all animals six months or age or older. A stamped duplicate application (stamped within 30 days) from the ADGA office will be accepted for animals younger than six months of age. Be aware of the limitations per ADGA show rules. Any ADGA guidance or rule in place as of August 7th, 2021 will supersede this rule in regards to the acceptance of stamped duplicate registrations.

6. **High Plains Jackpot** – Ring 3 will function as a jackpot show with 100% payback of early entries per breed. Payback will be in cash as you exit the ring following the table below. The High Plains Jackpot is funded by generous contributions of Nebraska goat producers and other anonymous donors.

- 7. There is **no pre-show milk out**. However, an over-distended udder is a very serious fault and will be discriminated against at judges discretion.
- 8. Exhibitors are asked to **dress** professionally and appropriately as outlined in the ADGA Guidebook.
- 9. **Health papers are not** required at our facility but may be required to cross state lines. Exhibitors are encouraged to abide by state or federal regulations regarding transport of animals for exhibition. Animals showing signs of illness or disease must be removed from the fairgrounds. The Show Committee's decisions will be final.
- 10. **Stall Availability** will begin Friday evening at 3:00 PM, All animals must be in place by 10:30 AM on Saturday, August 7th. Check in will be available Friday evening and again on Saturday morning from 9:00 AM 11:00 AM. If you desire to exhibit in only Sunday's Senior Doe Show, you may arrive that morning but must be in place by 7:00 AM. It will be your responsibility to find a show committee member to check your papers prior to the show start time of 8:00. If you are not checked in prior to this time, you will not be permitted into the ring.
- 11. **Entry fees -** \$6 per ring per animal for entries received by July 26th, 2021. Entries received after July 26th will be \$10 per ring. Enter early and take advantage of the discount! Substitutions will be allowed at no charge, provided they are made before check in has ended and will not be allowed once check-in is completed.

- 13. **Pens:** Pens must be pre-reserved and will be assigned. There are two types of pens available, horse stalls (10x10) and sheep/swine style pens (5x6) Horse stalls will be \$15 each, and sheep pens will be \$5 each. The show committee reserves the right to limit tack stalls and excessive penning requests in the event the barn nears capacity. Exhibitors will be notified personally if this becomes an issue. Pens must be cleaned prior to leaving the show. A local youth group will be on hand to clean your pens for a small fee if so desired.
- 14. Exhibitors are welcome to show off of their trailer if desired. Exhibitors planning to do so are asked to make note of this choice at entry, and will be parked in a designated area upon arrival.
- 15. **Wood Shavings** will be available for preorder until July 26th. Pre purchased shavings will be delivered to the fairgrounds and available upon your arrival. If you do not preorder, we can not guarantee there will be extra to purchase at the show.
- 16. **Hold Harmless** Exhibitors and attendees at the show are personally responsible for their own health, safety, and actions.
